

Duties/Responsibilities Cruising Fleet Captain – Racing

Racing goals and objectives – increase racing participation by at least 10% each year

Cruising Fleet responsibilities – help organize Club Fleet duties including Opening Day events (e.g. Sailpast) and Club BBQ; help host two monthly meetings; provide Race Patrol personnel as requested

Breakdown of Duties

- Organize and champion all cruising fleet racing including, but not limited to, Sunday races, Regattas, Wednesday Night racing, HRYRA, and special events such as the Long Distance Race and Seamanship Rally.
- Solicit and guarantee Cruising Fleet Race Patrol volunteers when needed.
- Attend all Fleet Captain meetings as required.
- Attend all monthly Club meetings and give Cruising Fleet report.
- Write a Cruising Fleet racing report each month for the ***Telltale*** (May through October).
- Be a non-adversarial liaison between the Race Committee and the Cruising fleet.
- Organize and champion adult sailing and Cruising Fleet mentorship, especially for new members.
- Assist Race Committee with writing and updating the Sailing Instructions for Sundays, Regattas and Wednesday nights.
- Guarantee all scored racers have a valid PHRF.
- Guarantee all scored racers have paid their Cruising Fleet dues.
